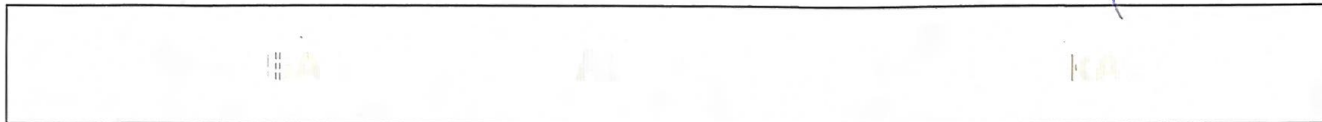

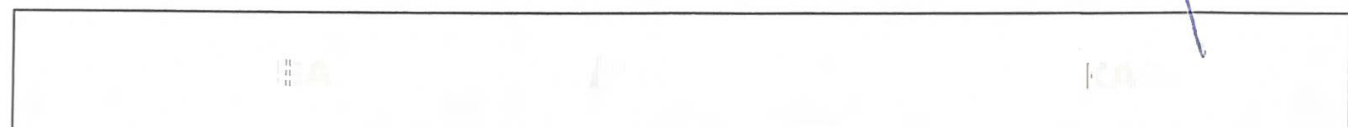

Mexico wins five-set battle with host team Canada

EDMONTON, CANADA. Sept. 23, 2023: Mexico defeated Canada in five sets today at the NORCECA Pan American Cup Men's Final Six, September 19 to 24 at the Flair Airlines Hangar (Expo Centre), in Edmonton, Alberta.

Jorge Azair, head coach of Mexico: “We wanted to win 3-0 to play in the final, but I proud that the team played well and was more disciplined today. Tomorrow will be a strong match because Cuba is a strong team. It will be a good game for us.”

Dan Lewis, head coach of Canada: “It was very difficult to do what we had to do tonight because Mexico is a very experienced team. ... We only had to win one set and we were down, so I'm proud of our guys for handling the stress of that situation.”

In reality, our goal is to look for the possibility of a medal tomorrow and fight for the bronze. Is not that we gave up the match, but the possibilities were not clear, and we decided to give opportunity to the players we are developing for the future.”
