Brazil wins gold at U-18 Pan Am Cup

GUATEMALA CITY, Guatemala, May 5, 2013 – Brazil Best Setter: Wilmarie Rivera P survived an exciting five-set battle of 2 hours and 29 minutes against Puerto Rico to claim the gold medal of the U-18 Girls Pan American Cup with a 20-25, 25-19, 25-13, 23-25, 15-12 victory at Teodoro Palacios Flores Gymnasium on Saturday.

Drussyla Costa with 20 points and Gabriela Candido and Lana Conceicao who each contributed 18 were Brazil's top scorers. For Puerto Rico, Genesis Miranda registered 22 points.

In the match for the bronze medal, Dominican Republic defeated Argentina 3-1 (25-16, 25-17, 20-25, 25-22) with Brayelin Martinez and Gaila Gonzalez leading the way with 24 and 19 points respectively.

"Our first title in this age-group category is an important one because the girls grow as players," Brazil's coach Mauricio Thomas said. "Puerto Rico had a lot of heart and courage."
