

## Exciting action in day two at the BVB double gender Pan Am Games

TORONTO, Canada, July 14, 2015. - The actions in day two of the double gender Beach Volleyball tournament at the Pan American Games was exciting with several duos undefeated.

In the men's division, Alvaro Morais and Victor Araujo of Brazil earned their second victory after prevailing 2-1 (21-15, 18-21, 15-10) over Venezuela's Jackson Henriquez and Jesus Villafañe. Cuban Nivaldo Diaz and Sergio Gonzalez executed with powerful kills over United States' Ian Satterfield and Miles Evans with a 2-0 (21-17, 21-15) victory, their second in the tournament.

Also undefeated, Lombardo Ontiveros and Juan Virgen of Mexico continue strong, in their second outing they beat Aruba's Eargennell De Cuba and Daniel Mitchel 2-0 (21-10, 21-9).

In their debut, the Canadian duo Josh Binstock and Sam Schachter had to use their best weapons to defeat Nicaragua's Ruben Mora and Dany Lopez 2-1 (21-14, 16-21, 15-10) under pouring rain.

In Pool A Renzo Cairus and Mauricio Vieyto of Uruguay made their debut with good rhythm defeating Guatemala's Julio Recinos and Luis Garcia 2-0 (21-15, 21-16). Ian Mehamed and Nicolas Capogrosso of Argentina in Pool C neutralized St. Lucia's Julian Bisette and Joseph Clercent energy in keeping the scores always close with a final 2-0 (21-17, 21-17) win.

In women, Brazilians Maestrini/Horta managed to beat Rivas/Mardones 21-16 and 21-7, to continue unbeaten in Pool B. Canada's Melissa Humana-Paredes and Taylor Pischke added one more solid victory in Pool A. The home girls defeated Lina Bernier and Eva Torruella of Puerto Rico 21-16, 21-15 to remain undefeated.

Karen Cope and Natalia Alfaro of Costa Rica won another Central American battle against Nicaragua's Elia Machado and Lolette Rodriguez with clear dominance 21-15, 21-9. This is Costa Rica's second victory in Pool B.

Joining the unbeaten duos were Uruguay's Eugenia Nieto and Fabiana Gomez of Pool A who crushed Chante Smith-Johnson and Ileann Powery of Cayman Islands 2-0 (21-7, 21-7).

Making their debut in Pool D, Argentina's Ana Gallay and Georgina Klug beat Trinidad and Tobago's Ayana Dyette/Malika Davidson 2-0 (21-11, 21-13) with well fought second set by the Caribbean duo. Despite Mexico's towering Bibiana Candelas efforts over the net and



Marta Revuelta's defending skills, Cubans Lianma Flores and Leila Martinez controlled the actions with strong spikes 2-0 (21-18, 21-18) in Pool D.
