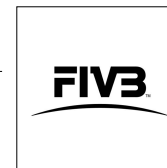

Coaches ready for CAZOVA/World qualifiers in Haiti

JUVENAT, PETION-VILLE, HAITI, JULY 8, 2016: The coaches of host country Haiti, Curacao, Cayman Islands and US Virgin Islands all expressed an eager to serve off their campaigns in the new qualification process to the 2017 Caribbean Zonal Volleyball Association (CAZOVA) Championships to be held in Trinidad and Tobago.

The four-team event which begins on Saturday at the Gymnasium Vincent "Tek Kale" Port-au-Prince, will be off added importance to all the participants because it also doubles as a Round One CAZOVA qualifier to the 2018 FIVB World Indoor Championship to be jointly hosted by Italy and Bulgaria.

Ranked seventh by CAZOVA, Haiti will play host to a four-team round-robin series involving Curacao, ranked fifth and its expected main rival as well as US Virgin Islands and Cayman Islands, which are rated at 11th and 12th.

Four years ago, when all four countries also participated in the qualifiers to the 2014 FIVB under a different format which incorporated all zones from round one, Haiti feared the best.

Back then, the Haitians reached as far as the Third Round of qualifiers while Cayman Islands and US Virgin Islands did not get past the first hurdle, and Curacao was ousted in Round Two.

And looking ahead to their round-robin series, the four coaches expressed optimism and hope for a good showing from their respective teams.

Melissa Schjang-Simmons (US Virgin Islands) was quick to point out that she has a very young team, but one which is very high on energy, with a lot of expectations to do well.

"The group is very focus and excited, even though our preparations was hampered by not having the full team together.

"You have to remember, US Virgin Islands is comprised of four different islands, so that is a problem we will tend to face a lot."

Mark Ray (Cayman Islands) quickly pointed out that his team was not at full numbers because a lot of the players had previous commitments.

However, he said this will not deter them in their quest to get to the next round of qualification.

"We may not be at full strength as the other teams or have much youth, but we have a lot of experience within our group and we are here to give a good showing of ourselves.

"Our preparation was not as good as we would have liked, but as coach of the team I believe we can still show great team spirit and consistency, which is important in tournaments like these."

Patricio Bridgewater (Curacao) warned that while he had little information on the teams he would be facing over the two days of competition his team was primed to do well.

"Our preparation began in February, while he finalized the team in March and have been working towards this qualifying series since.

"We don't really know what to expect from our opponents, but at the same time we are well motivated, highly spirited, well organized and have a very strong team chemistry and looking to do a good job."

Yves Larrieux (Haiti), boasted that his Haitian team which is hosting a qualification group of any kind under CAZOVA or NORCECA for the first time at any age-group was ready to perform in front its home crowd.

“We have been well prepared mentally, physically and tactically and we have been working very hard over the past few weeks, sometimes twice per day to make sure we are ready.

“The guys are in very good shape and I think we have a very good chance to qualify to the next step.”

Speaking on the eve of the matches Margarette Graham, President of the Haitian Volleyball Federation (DNF) said she was excited that her country was hosting the event and there was a big hope for an excellent tournament.

Graham said, “As for our team, we have a very good group of young players, so for us it’s a new generation of players for us who will be looking to make their mark.

“They are all very excited and as host country I am confident that we will be able to get among the top two and advance to the next phase of qualifiers and the CAZOVA Championship Finals.

Apart from this group of qualifiers in Haiti, the two other four-country First Round Qualification groups features Bahamas-3, Aruba-8, Martinique-9 and Bonaire-4 (Pool A) and Suriname-4, Jamaica-6, Guadeloupe-10 and Turks & Caicos-13 (Pool-B) and will both be contested in late October.

At the conclusion of each of the first round group qualifiers, the top two teams will both advance to the next round where they will joint top ranked nation and reigning CAZOVA champions Trinidad and Tobago, and perennial champions and second ranked Barbados in the eight-team finals.

From the eight-team final the top two teams overall will again qualify to the next round of FIVB World Championship qualification at NORCECA while crowning the eventual champions of CAZOVA.

At the NORCECA Continental, the CAZOVA duo will join the USA, Cuba, Canada, Mexico, Costa Rica and Puerto Rico along with two from Central America and two from the Eastern Caribbean Zonal Volleyball Association (ECVA) in the top-12 qualification process to determine the eventual qualifiers to the World Championships.
