





Dominicans, USA and Cuba for Supremacy of Pan Am Cup

LIMA, Peru, June 13, 2017 – Defending champions Dominican Republic, Cuba and United States will be vying to take the top position of the overall standings of the Women's Pan American Cup whose sixteenth edition sponsored by Movistar will take place in Lima and Cañete, Peru from June 17 to 25.

Those countries are already tied with fourth crowns each at the premier's annual intercontinental women's volleyball competition.

Cuba won the inaugural event in 2002 and repeated in 2004-05 and in 2007. The United States finished first in 2003, 2012-13 and 2015 while the Dominican Republic won in 2008, 2010, 2014 and 2016. Brazil who is not taking part in the competition this year, won it three times in 2006, 2009 and 2011.

All the 44 matches of the Pan American Cup will be available on video streaming at NORCECA TV for only \$13.

The Dominicans are the team with more podiums with 14, adding seven silver medals and three bronze medals to their four crowns. The United States are next with 9 -two silver and three bronze medals.

The defending champions won their fourth title with a five-set victory over Puerto Rico in 2016 when the competition was held in Santo Domingo. It was the best ever finish for Puerto Rico who had two bronze medals.
