



USA, Dominican Republic and Argentina with 2-0 after two days

TRUJILLO AND CHICLAYO, Peru, July 7, 2019 – Defending champions United States, Dominican Republic and Argentina claimed their second victory in as many days at the XVIII Women's Volleyball Pan American Cup.

The Americans have a 2-0 mark with the full 10 points after two 3-0 wins in Pool B in Chiclayo. The Dominicans lead Pool A with 2-0 and 8 points while the Argentineans are next with 7 points and 2-0.

Dominican Republic 3, Guatemala 0

Dominican Republic crushed Guatemala in three sets (25-6, 25-8, 25-10), in the first game of the second day. In one hour the Dominican team got the victory with the high performance of Yonkaira Peña who scored 21 points and Marifranchi Rodríguez with 12 points. Rut Gómez was Guatemala's best scorer with 8 points. Dominicana got 13 direct service points, with 8 points by Peña.

United States 3, Trinidad & Tobago 0

United States stormed past Trinidad & Tobago 3-0 (25-14, 25-15, 25-13) for their second victory in as many days. Veronica Curry led four Americans who finished in double figures with 14 points. Danielle Cuttino was next with 13 points, while Kathryn Plummer and Brione Butler added 11 and 10, respectively. Darlene Ramdin was the best of Trinidad & Tobago with 8

Canada 3, Cuba 0

Canada defeated Cuba in straight sets 3-0 (25-19, 25-21, 25-22) to even its record at 1-1 in Pool A. Kiera Van Ryk and Alexa Lea Gray stood out for Canada with 16 and 15 points, respectively. Diaris Pérez led Cuba with 15 and Greisy Fine added 10. Canada held a clear advantage in aces 7-2 and got the edge in blocks 7-6. Cuban Claudia Hernández had four blocks.

Argentina 3, Peru 1

Argentina recovered from losing the first set and went on to defeat Peru 3-1 (18-25, 25-21, 25-15, 25-19) in Pool A. Julieta Lazcano topped Argentina with 15 points, followed by Lucia Fresco with 14 and Paula Nizetich and Daniela Bullaich with 13 points apiece. For Peru, Angela Leyva and Karla Ortiz each registered 15 points while Clarivett Yllescas added 10. Argentina scored 12 blocks, six of them by Agnes Michel Tosi.

Puerto Rico 3, Colombia 1

Stephanie Enright and Paulina Prieto recorded 22 and 21 points, respectively, to lead the victory of Puerto Rico over Colombia 3-1 (25-21, 26-24, 23-25, 25-20) in Pool B. Ana Sofia added 15 for the winners. Dayana Segovia and Amanda Coneo each scored 16 points for Colombia. Puerto Rico led in attacks 61-51, blocks 10-6 and aces 3-2.
