## USA will meet Cuba for the gold medal

MEXICALI, Baja California.- USA will meet Cuba in the match for the gold medal of the Women's Volleyball Pan American Cup after beating the Dominican Republic in their semifinal game by score of 25-16, 26-28, 25-18, 25-21.

In the other semifinal, Cuba had a party time scoring an overwhelming victory over Brazil by score of 25-12, 25-11, 25-10.

Dominican Republic will play against Brazil for the bronze medal in the first match on Saturday starting at 6:00 p.m.

Nancy Metcalf led the Americans with 23 points and Nnamani followed with 19 while Thomas added 15. For the Dominicans, Kenia Moreta had 15, Milagros Cabral 12 and Rivera 11.

Zoila Barros led the balanced Cuban offense with 18 points. Dulce Tellez and Daimi Ramirez had 9 apiece, Liana Mesa scored 8 and Ortiz 7. For Brazil Regiane Bidas and Adenizia Silva each had 7 points.

In the other match of Friday's schedule, Canada beat Puerto Rico 25-16, 25-19, 25-19 and finished in fifth place.

Emely Cordonier had 19 points for Canada, Bard Bellini scored 10 and



Lies Verhoeff and Melisa Raymond had 8 apiece. For Puerto Rico Karina Ocasio and Alexandra Oquendo each scored 10 points.
