Dominican Republic confirms Women's U-23 Pan Am Title

Ica, Peru, September 13, 2014. - Dominican Republic wins their second consecutive U-23 Women's Pan American Title beating Colombia 3-1 (24-26, 27-25, 25-23, 25-11) in the Gold Medal match of the tournaments' second edition at Jose Oliva Razzeto Coliseum in the City of Ica.

The match was well disputed in the first three sets a strong performance from both sides, longer rallies, strong kills and similar errors; it was up to the fourth period when the champions' blocking crushed Colombia's offensive line over the net.

The outstanding Dominican blocking once again was their weapon surpassing Colombia with a huge 22-6 advantage. Colombia did better in attacks by 52-47 and both scored 4 points via aces. Dominicans made 23 unforced errors against 23 from Colombia.

Captain Brayelin Martinez scored a match-high of 26 points, with 20 kills, 4 blocks and 1 ace, also opposite Gaila Gonzalez contributed to the winning cause with 23 points and outside hitter Yonkaira Peña added 13. Colombia's double-digit scorers were Amanda Caneo (14), Ivonee Montaña (13), Diana Arrechea (12) and Maria Martinez (10).

Top scorer, captain Brayelin Martinez, said "I am very proud of my team that was able to finish in first place on second occasion in this tournament."

Colombian captain Maria Marin expressed "today Colombia couldn't take advantage of the opportunities presented during the match. In the second set we were up by five points and Dominican Republic tied and won the match. Colombia is a team used to playing final matches, during the past month we have played two, at the South American championship in Colombia and now the Pan American Cup; they have more experience as well as Brazil and we hope no to get used to playing them but winning them and not end with the silver medal".

Wagner Pacheco de Brazil, head coach of Dominican Republic thanked his group "the players got involved in their technical preparation, I am very glad that they played with aggressiveness, and hot blooded that made the team come out of difficult moments and seal with the victory. I congratulate Mauro because he has done a good job with this team and grown in a short period of time".

Brazilian coach Mauro Marasciulo, for Colombia said, "It's difficult to work in Colombia where there is little competition, in the second set we held an advantage but the Dominicans cached up with three service points. Nevertheless we are happy with the result".

Bronze Medal Cuba 3, Peru 1

Cuba claimed the Bronze Medal prevailing over hosts Peru 3-1 (25-21, 25-16, 19-25, 25-17) with impressive 31 points from young Melissa Vargas. Young Melissa Vargas scored a tournament-high of 31 points, including 24 kills, 3 blocks and 4 aces to stop the home team's efforts; Peru was left out of options while Cuba dominated with stronger kills to finish in third place. Cuba was challenged by Peru on several occasions; they even lost the fourth period with considerable advantage. Cuba showed superiority with a 50-38 margin in attacks and in the blocking category with 12-7; their serves weren't that significant over Peru (7-6) nor did the unforced errors by each team, Cuba have 28 and Peru 25. Joining opposite player Vargas, were outside hitters Regla Garcia and Sulian Matienzo with 10 tallies apiece. Captain Angela Leyva led Peru with 16 points, followed by Katherine Regalado with 12 points.

Mexico 3, Argentina 2

Mexico outclassed Argentina 3-2 (25-20, 16-25, 23-25, 25-23, 15-13) to finish in fifth place. Mexico began on top and after losing two sets they recovered to tie the match and finishing with a thrilling tie-break rematch as they lost to Argentina in the preliminary round in straight sets. Outside hitter Lisbeth Sainz with 23 points and opposite



player Andrea Rangel with 20 points topped the winners offensive line, while Jocelyn Urias added 10 in the match that lasted 2 hours and 25 minutes; the fourth set delayed 27 minutes to start as the shining sun over the court made it impossible to continue. With also 23 units, Micaela Fabian led Argentina's scorers, followed by Camila Hiruela (16), they only ones with double-figures. Argentina held advantage in service (8-5), while in blocking (11-10) and in attacks (59-49) the winners were better.

Costa Rica 3, Trinidad and Tobago 1

Costa Rica finished in seventh place defeating Trinidad and Tobago 3-1 (19-25, 25-22, 25-21, 25-17), their only victory at the Cup. The pale match showed both teams with a similar performance, both scored 43 points via attacks, Trinidad and Tobago was better in blocking 7-6 and in serves 15-10, but they committed 35 unforced errors against 20 from the Central Americans, who from the second set forward hurt the Caribbean's defense. Tania Carazo (17) and Mijal Hines (15) topped Costa Rica's scorers, the only with double-figures, but two opponents led all scorers, Channon Thompson the most experienced of all with 23 and Marishe Herbert (20), Makila York added 10.

Colombia es un equipo que se está acostumbrando a jugar finales, en menos de un mes ya llevamos dos con el Sudamericano en Colombia y ahora esta Copa Panamericana, en cambio ellas ya tienen experiencia en esto al igual que Brasil; pero esperemos que nosotras ya nos vayamos acostumbrando a no sólo jugarlas, sino también ganarlas y no quedarnos sólo con la medalla de plata”.

Wagner Pacheco de Brasil, director técnico de República Dominicana, agradeció a su grupo “las jugadoras se involucraron en el trabajo técnico, estoy muy contento de lo que demostraron en la cancha de jugar con garra, con sangre caliente que supo elevar los ánimos en los momentos que caíamos y con ello cerrar el partido con victoria. Mis felicitaciones a Mauro por el trabajo que ha hecho con su selección que ha crecido mucho en poco tiempo”.

El brasileño, Mauro Marasciulo, entrenador de Colombia dijo “Colombia no es un país fácil para el trabajo, tenemos una competencia interna muy pequeña que limita un poco el desarrollo del juego, en el segundo set teníamos la ventaja, pero Dominicana logró alcanzarnos con tres puntos de saque. Sin embargo, estamos muy felices con los resultados”.

Medalla de Bronce Cuba 3, Perú 1

Cuba ganó la medalla de Bronce venciendo a Perú 3-1 (25-21, 25-16, 19-25, 25-17) con impresionantes 31 puntos de la juvenil Melissa Vargas. La joven Melissa Vargas anotó la máxima puntuación del torneo con 31 puntos, incluyendo 24 en ataques, 3 en bloqueos y 4 puntos de ases para detener los esfuerzos del equipo de casa; Perú se quedó sin opciones en tanto que Cuba dominaba con potentes ataques para finalizar en el tercer lugar. Cuba fue presionado por Perú en varias ocasiones incluso perdiendo el cuarto parcial por una ventaja considerable. Cuba mostró superioridad con ventaja de 50-38 en puntos de ataque y en la categoría de bloqueo por 12-7; sus servicios no fueron significativos sobre Perú (7-6) ni los errores no forzados de ambos equipos, Cuba con 28 y Perú con 25. Acompañando a la opuesta Vargas, estuvieron las atacantes Regla García y Sulian Matienzo con 10 puntos cada una. La capitana Angela Leyva encabezó a Perú con 16 puntos, seguida por Katherine Regalado con 12 puntos.



México 3, Argentina 2

El equipo de México superó al de Argentina 3-2 (25-20, 16-25, 23-25, 25-23, 15-13) para concluir quinto. Las mexicanas comenzaron arriba y tras dos tramos perdidos supieron reponerse para empatar y luego concretar en un excitante tie-break el éxito en partido de revancha para desquitarse del revés que en la apertura de este torneo le infligieron las argentinas en sets corridos. La jugadora de punta Lisbeth Saínez con 23 puntos y la opuesta Andrea Rangel con 20 encabezaron la ofensiva de las ganadoras, en tanto Jocelyn Urias aportó 10 en un juego que se extendió a 2 horas y 25 minutos, pues el cuarto set comenzó 27 minutos después de lo previsto dado el fuerte sol que imperó en la cancha, sin precedentes durante todos estos días en que primaron las bajas temperaturas. Por Argentina también sumó 23 unidades la opuesta Micaela Fabián, seguida por Camila Hiruela (16), únicas con doble dígitos por su equipo, que aventajo a México en el servicio (8-5), pero no en bloqueos (11-10) y en ataques (59-49).

Costa Rica 3, Trinidad y Tobago 1

Costa Rica aseguró el séptimo lugar al derrotar a Trinidad y Tobago 3-1 (19-25, 25-22, 25-21, 25-17), única victoria en la Copa. El pálido encuentro estuvo bastante parejo, ambos con 43 puntos de ataque, incluso las trinitarias estuvieron arriba 7-6 en bloqueo y 15-10 en el saque, pero cometieron 35 errores por 20 las centroamericanas, quienes a partir del segundo parcial hicieron más daño a la defensa de las caribeñas. Por Costa Rica Tania Carazo (17) y Mijal Hines (15) fueron las que más tributaron y únicas con doble dígitos, pero dos adversarias fueron las máximas anotadoras del partido, la más experimentada, Channon Thompson (23), y Marisha Herbert (20), mientras Makila York agregó 10.
