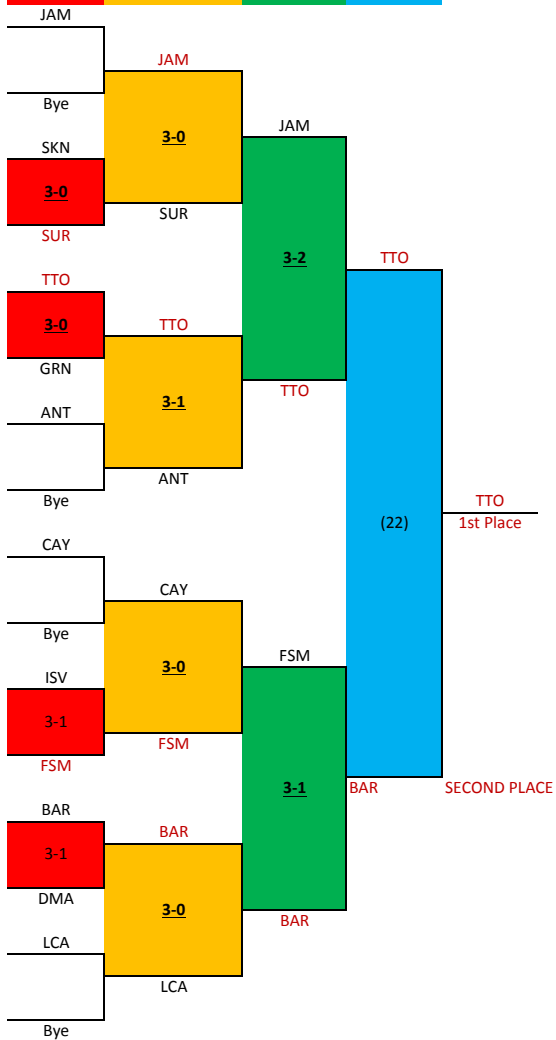

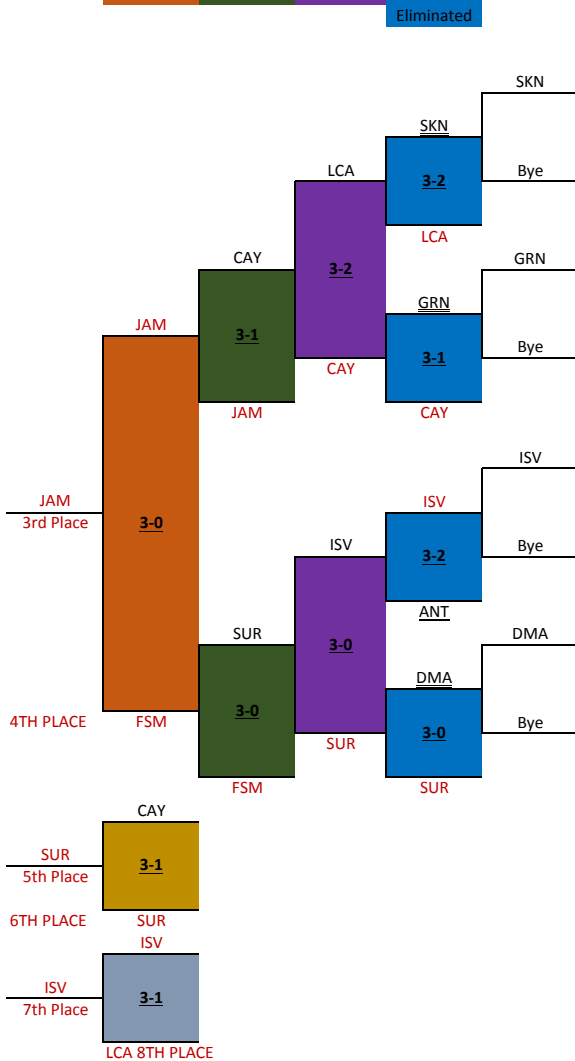

## **Trinidad & Tobago wins CAZOVA/ECVA Women's BVB Olympic Qualifier**

OCHO RIOS, Jamaica, January 31, 2016. - Trinidad & Tobago won the Second Round of the Women's NORCECA Continental Cup Inter Zonal CAZOVA/ECVA Olympic Qualifier claiming the gold medal over Barbados by 3-1 at Ocho Rios Bay in Jamaica.

Dyana Dyette with partner Malika Davidson of Trinidad-A capped both matches against Barbados. They first smoothly beat Sharon Bovell/Anthazia Mason of Barbados-B by 2-0 (21-10, 21-14) and then managed to control the actions over Shari Matthews/Anicia Wood of Barbados-A by 2-0 (21-17, 21-12).

Dayana and Malika finished their series first and had to wait for Apphia Glasgow and La Teisha Joseph of Trinidad-B to celebrate three intense days of competition. Apphia and La Teisha Joseph, who despite losing to Shari Matthews/Anicia Wood, stood up to Sharon Bovell/Anthazia Mason by 2-0 (21-19, 21-16) to crown Trinidad & Tobago champions.

Ayana, after winning the gold expressed her joy "winning was my goal coming here, because I wasn't able to compete in the first round. I am so happy to have accomplished it and that our both teams were able to play well". Speaking about her teammate Malika, she said "we had a game plan and to remain calm, using our strength to score".

She also added that Trinidad & Tobago wasn't settling for less than gold and she praised the Jamaican Volleyball Association for organizing the tournament.

Malika also had words to say "we worked very hard for this; I believe it will hit me later on, I am so excited; both teams came to do our best and our best is gold; it's surreal".

Jamaica finished with the bronze medal following their victory over French St. Martin by 3-0. To reach the bronze medal match they defeated Cayman Islands 3-1

The Third Round Olympic qualifier of the NORCECA Women's Continental Cup will be in May at El Salvador, featuring the top eight ranked CAZOVA/ECVA teams and the top four Central American teams competing for six spots in the Fourth Round in Acapulco.

## **Trinidad & Tobago gana preolímpico femenino de CAZOVA/ECVA**

OCHO RÍOS, Jamaica, 31 de enero, 2016. - Trinidad & Tobago ganó la Segunda Ronda Femenina de la Copa Continental NORCECA fase Inter Zonal de CAZOVA/ECVA clasificatoria a Juegos Olímpicos, tras su triunfo en el juego por la medalla de oro ante Barbados por 3-1 en la Bahía Ocho Ríos de Jamaica.

Dyana Dyette junto a su compañera Malika Davidson de Trinidad-A dominaron los dos juegos ante Barbados. Primero vencieron sin problemas a Sharon Bovell/Anthazia Mason de Barbados-B por 2-0 (21-10, 21-14) y luego controlaron las acciones sobre Shari Matthews/Anicia Wood de Barbados-A por 2-0 (21-17, 21-12).

Dayana y Malika fueron las primeras en finalizar su serie, por lo que tuvieron que esperar a Apphia Glasgow y La Teisha Joseph de Trinidad-B para celebrar. Apphia y La Teisha, a pesar de haber caído ante Shari Matthews/Anicia Wood, jugaron fuertemente frente a Sharon Bovell/Anthazia Mason por 2-0 (21-19, 21-16) para coronarse campeonas.

Luego del triunfo, Ayana expresó con mucha emoción “ganar era mi meta porque no pude estar en la primera ronda. Estoy muy contenta con lo que alcanzamos y que nuestros dos equipos se desempeñaron bien”. Sobre su compañera Malika dijo “nos trazamos un plan de juego y mantuvimos la calma, usamos nuestra fuerza para anotar”.

También agregó que Trinidad & Tobago no iba a conformarse con menos que la medalla de oro y además agradeció a la Asociación de Voleibol de Jamaica por la organización del evento.

Malika también tuvo unas palabras “trabajamos mucho para este logro, no me lo creo aún, estoy muy emocionada; ambos equipos venimos a dar lo mejor y lo mejor fue el oro; es surreal”.



Por su lado Jamaica dominó a Islas Caimán 3-1 y luego venció a San Martín Francesa 3-0 para quedarse con la medalla de bronce.

La Tercera Ronda Femenina de la Copa Continental NORCECA clasificatoria a Juegos Olímpicos será en mayo en El Salvador, en donde los ocho principales de CAZOVA/ECVA y los cuatro principales de Centro América competirán por seis plazas en la Cuarta Ronda a disputarse en Acapulco.
