The victory assures Venezuela (2-1) of a spot in at least the quarterfinals, which will be played on Saturday. Mexico (0-3) will play for 5th-8th place starting on Sunday.

Almost every player on Venezuela's roster started at least one set as it led Mexico in spikes (51-40), blocks (9-8) and aces (6-1). Venezuela's hitting percentage was .314 as compared to Mexico's .186. At times, Mexico's emotions got the better of the young team, which caused mistakes.

Brazil (3-0), which is using the Pan American Cup to prepare for the FIVB Under-23 World Championship, will advance directly to Sunday's semifinals. Canada (2-1) will play in Saturday's quarterfinals.

Brazil led Canada in spikes (49-38) and blocks (9-2). The teams tied in aces (2-2) and Canada scored 17 points off Brazil errors while committing 15. Brazil's hitting efficiency was .506 while Canada's was .329.

Brazil outside hitter Douglas Souza led all scorers with 14 points on a match-high 13 spikes and one ace. Outside hitter Carlos Barreto added 13 points on 10 spikes and three blocks. Middle blocker Flavio Gualberto had a match-high five blocks.

Canada was led by opposite Casey Schouten with 11 points on 10 spikes and one ace. Outside hitter Stephen Maar totaled 10 points on 10 spikes.

Canada had its best effort in the third set when it led 20-18. But Brazil responded with a 4-0 scoring run to end the threat.

Brazil Captain Thiago Veloso

"It was a great match and I think we are getting better and better each day. This is our goal, to train each day to get better. We're very happy to be in the semifinal and we're working to play better every day."

Brazil Coach Roberley Leonaldo

It was a good match. We played really well in the first and second sets and we made fewer mistakes in our serve. Our blocking could be better as well as our defense, in the third set we had some problems there. The team needed what they needed to do to win. Every day we have to improve and we'll do that for the semifinals.

Canada Captain Brett Walsh

"We're not too happy with our performance. Credit to Brazil they were a good team that played a great match against us. We have some work to do and things to fix to be successful going forward. They executed really well and we weren't able adjust. We weren't quite ready to play their style of game. In the next couple of days and hopefully we'll improve."

"We didn't pass well in the beginning. We need to be a bit more ready and our serve was not as effective and we were hesitating at certain points which created doubt and that's not good. We'll be ready for tomorrow."



RENO, USA (Aug. 14, 2015) – Argentina advanced to the semifinals of the Pan American Cup with a 25-21, 25-22, 24-26, 25-23 win over the United States on Friday at the Reno Events Center.

Argentina (3-0) won Pool B and will advance straight to Sunday's semifinals. The U.S. (2-1) finished third in Pool B and will play Canada (2-1) in the 7 p.m. quarterfinal on Saturday.

The U.S. team has only been practicing together a short time and Argentina took advantage of its weaknesses, particularly in passing. Argentina led in spikes (54-49) and scored on 37 U.S. errors while committing 22.

The U.S. led in blocks (14-5) and aces (7-3). Argentina had a hitting efficiency of .287 while the United States' was .252.

Argentina outside hitter Lisandro Zanotti led his team with 16 points on 15 spikes and one block. Opposite Federico Martina added 11 points on nine spikes and two blocks.

U.S. outside hitter Greg Petty led all scorers with 15 attacks and a match-high four aces. Outside hitter AJ Nally totaled 11 points on eight spikes and one ace. Middle blocker Jeff Jendryk and setter Jonah Seif each had three blocks for the U.S.

After winning the first two sets, Argentina led 19-14 in the third. The U.S. got a 4-0 run to pull to within one point. But Argentina came back with a kill. Argentina's serving error gave the U.S. its final point before Argentina's kill ended the match.

Argentina Head Coach Martin Ariel Lopez

"It was a tough because we both we're looking for first place in the pool. We knew that we had an advantage of the number of sets won and we were patient in the match to let it flow and develop into what we wanted.
