U-18 NORCECA CHAMPIONSHIP

San Juan, Puerto Rico, September 2-7, 2016

Tickets to semifinals to be decided on Sunday

SAN JUAN, Puerto Rico, September 4, 2016 – Title holders Dominican Republic and seven-time champions United States are set to battle for the top position in Pool B and a direct ticket to the semifinals at the NORCECA Girls' U18 Continental Championship at Pedrin Zorrilla Coliseum on Sunday.

Mexico and hosts Puerto Rico, the other two undefeated teams in the competition, will face each other for the supremacy in Pool A.

The NORCECA Girls' U18 Championship offers two tickets to next year's FIVB World Championship to be held in Argentina.



United States 3, Barbados 0

USA team used all the players in roster to defeat Barbados 3-0 in a Pool B match. The Americans dominated with scores of 25-13, 25-8, 25-11 for their second win of the championship. Haley Warner and Skylar Fields with 9

and 8 points were the best scorers for the United States. Ashley Jordan led the Caribbean side with seven points.



Mexico 3, French St. Martin 0

Mexico needed only 58 minutes to beat French St Marten 3-0 (25-1, 25-6, 25-2) for its second win. Melanie Parra led the scorers of Mexico with 14 points. Mexicans squad totaled 31 aces and 22 attacks.



Dominican Republic 3, Guatemala 0

The Dominican Republic continued en route to the defense of their U-18 Continental title after beating Guatemala (25-7, 25-9, 25-11). Natalia Martinez with 19 points, Madeline Guillen with 14 and Jazmin Feliz with 12, were the best scorers for the Dominican Republic.



Puerto Rico 3, Costa Rica 0

Puerto Rico remained unbeaten by beating Costa Rica 3-0 (25-10, 25-3, 27-25) in Pool A action. Paulina Perez had 13 points as the top scorer for Puerto Rico, followed by Sofia Victoria and Loraine Lopez with 10 points each. Isla Johnson had 13 for Costa Rica.
