## Barbados works for win against Saint Vincent at U21 men's championship

GATINEAU, Canada, July 6, 2016 – Captain Andriy Stapleton scored 13 points to boost Barbados to a straight-sets 3-0 (25-23, 25-19, 25-17) victory against Saint Vincent and the Grenadines in Group A play at the U21 NORCECA Men's Continental Championship.

Following a see-saw opening set and a taut second, Barbados (1-1) took control against a developing and determined Saint Vincent squad. Carlos Cyrus scored 10 points (eight kills on 14 attacks, two blocks) and Ahkeem Mayers contributed eight, including two timely aces. Asmond Franklyn scored 10 points, including eight kills, to lead Saint Vincent (0-1) and Ronaldo Franklyn scored all nine of his points through kills.

Barbados, which has a bye on Thursday, will likely finish second in Group A and face the Group B third-place finisher in a quarter-final on Friday.

“Today's game we started very slowly in all three sets,” said Stapleton, who had a match-high 11 kills from 22 attacks. “The passing was better [than it was against the USA on Tuesday] but not as good as it could be. We improved our serving game. This win was important since it qualified us for second.”

Barbados was successful on 33 of 67 attacks, while Saint Vincent converted 19 of 73. Barbados was credited with 9-7 edge in digs. They needed three unanswered points to take a 24-minute opening set. In the second, they held tenuous 8-7 and 16-14 leads at the technical timeouts.

“That was a very good game from Saint Vincent,” Barbados coach John Stuart said. “We need to concentrate on our passing. Hopefully by quarter-finals and semifinals it will be what we need it to be. We will practice hard [Thursday] to get ready for the quarter-finals.”

Saint Vincent stayed in contact with a more experienced opponent for most of the way. Their finest moment was likely a Ronaldo Franklyn kill from a Shevron Caine back-set that gave them their last lead, 23-22, of the first set.

“Our first effort was not bad,” Saint Vincent coach Vance Andrews said. “Our team has to get accustomed to play under these conditions that we are not used to. The next game [against the USA on Thursday] I think they will be doing better.

“It's a tough competition for us. We have never really played this level of volleyball before. We are here to get experience and take it to the next level.”

If not for a few small technical errors, Saint Vincent might have forced Barbados to a fourth set.





“It was good, but we made some unforced errors – service errors and our reception was off,” Saint Vincent captain Delshun Welcome said. “But our hitting was there. We have to work on our reception and faults.

“We have to prepare for the USA,” Welcome added. “They are a tough team with the highest rank, so we have to focus and try our best to move on to the next round.” Saint Vincent faces the USA on Thursday at 4 p.m. to complete Group A play.

## **Cuba tunes up serving, sweeps Guatemala at U21 men's championship**

GATINEAU, Canada, July 6, 2016 – Cuba served up 13 aces, including six from co-scoring leader Jose Romero Gonzalez, while defeating Guatemala 3-0 (25-17, 25-17, 25-10) in Group B play at the U21 NORCECA Men's Continental Championship on Wednesday.

Romero Gonzalez (six kills, one block) and Miguel Lopez (eight kills, three aces and two blocks) each scored 13 points for Cuba (2-0), while Roamy Alonso contributed a team-high nine kills. For Guatemala (0-2), Carlos Lopez Santiago was top scorer with eight points and Erik Flores added seven.

Cuba converted 30-of-59 attacks while Guatemala converted 20-of-58. Cuba came away buoyed ahead of their likely first-place showdown against host Canada at 8 p.m. Thursday.

“We know Team Canada – they always have a good team, very tall,” said Cuba outside hitter Miguel David Gutierrez, who scored four of his points on aces. “We are ready for this game ... We trained very well in Cuba for this championship.”

Lopez served an ace on match point, which was appropriate to how the match played out at Centre Sportif de Gatineau.

“The serving was the best part of the game,” Cuba’s coach Jesus Angel Cruz said. “The rest of our game was the same way that is was [Tuesday, in a 3-0 win against Trinidad and Tobago]. We can play much better.”

Guatemala's stated objective for the U21 is to help their core players prepare for the Central America U23 championship in a few weeks. The fact that they were credited with 10 digs was evidence of their resolve.

“We feel very happy for one more experience against Cuba,” Flores said. “It was very useful for increasing our level of play. We will continue to get better.”



Guatemala had their challenges with absorbing Cuba's hitting power, but the experience is something they can carry over when they play their regional rivals.

“Working with a team of that level, it gives us a lot more experience,” coach Reider Lucas noted. “It is very valuable for us.”

Thursday in Group B, Guatemala faces Trinidad and Tobago at 6 p.m. Eastern time, while Canada and Cuba meet in the 8 p.m. match.

## **Canada, Cuba to meet for Group B top spot at U21 men's championship**

GATINEAU, Canada, July 6, 2016 – Canada beat Trinidad and Tobago 3-0 (25-19, 25-9, 25-18) at the U21 NORCECA Men's Continental Championship, which sets up a Group B first-place showdown against Cuba on Thursday.

At Centre Sportif de Gatineau in Quebec, Eric Loeppky had a match-high 14 points (including nine kills from 17 attacks, two blocks and three aces). Taryq Sani and Sharone Vernon-Evans had matching eight-point contributions, with seven kills apiece. Marlon Phillip had 10 points (all through kills, from 31 attacks) to top Trinidad and Tobago, which is the youngest squad in the seven-team event.

Canada converted 39 kills from 76 attacks, while Trinidad and Tobago converted 20 of 67.

“I told them step two is over – now we play Cuba, and that will be a different game,” Canada coach Gino Brousseau said, referring to the match at 8 p.m. on Thursday. “Sometimes when you play a team like Cuba it is easier, in the sense that they play the same style of game as you.

“In a situation like this it can be tough, because you're expected to win,” Brousseau added. “So all the pressure is on you. They're at the learning stage of their careers where they're figuring out how to deal with that. I know we can play better volleyball than we did tonight ... We did a couple good things. We worked hard on the blocks this morning at practice and we were more disciplined in the game.”

Canada's strongest sustained stretch, as the scoreline would indicate, came during the second set. Setter C.J. Gavlas coordinated a smooth attack before giving way to Derek Epp for the third.

“He [Gavlas] has been playing fantastic – I think we all have,” Canada middle blocker Matthew Passalent said.



“Our performance boosted our confidence going into tomorrow's match,” Passalent added. “We always love a good fight. We try not to focus on who we are playing and try to play our game.”

Trinidad and Tobago pulled together with a respectable final set after fraying during the lopsided second.

“We just gained more confidence,” Phillip said. “Against a team like that, we just have keep our rhythm and support each other on the court. Use our hands and move.”

The Caribbean squad will stand more eye-to-eye against Guatemala at 6 p.m. Thursday, since each team has an average height of 181 cm. The match will be for third in Group B and a quarter-final berth.

“We appreciate a match with this intensity,” Trinidad and Tobago coach Gideon Dickson said. “It was very beneficial from our standpoint. At no point in time, certainly not when we play in the Caribbean championship, do we play a team with this size. During the first and third sets, we understood what we needed to compete at this level.”

Thursday's Group B play begins with the 6 p.m. Guatemala facing Trinidad and Tobago. The victor will be assured of playing at least two more matches, while the other team will only have Saturda
